Please, read this information before you apply to SCEPS (School of Continuing Education and Professional Studies) UNIUYO for admission.

- 1. UTME scores are **NOT** needed.
- 2. Certificate Courses: Those applying for admissions into certificate programmes must possess, among other things, at least three (3) O' level credit passes from at most two (2) sittings.
- **3. Diploma Courses**: Those applying for admissions into diploma programmes must possess, among other things, at least four (4) O' level credit passes from at most two (2) sittings.
- **4. Bachelor's Degree Course**: Those applying for a bachelor's degree programmes must possess, among other things, five (5) O' level credit passes including Mathematics, English Language and any other three (3) subjects (as stipulated by the department) from at most two (2) sittings. (Sandwich porgramme is a bachelor's degree programme.
- **5. Postgraduate Diploma (PGD):** Candidates applying for a PGD programme must possess, among other things, five (5) O' level credit passes including Mathematics, English Language and any other three (3) subjects as specified by the department from at most two (2) sittings.
- **6. Master's in Law** (note: this is not an LLM programme). Those applying for a Master's in Law must possess, among other things, five (5) O' level credit passes from at most two (2) sittings.
- 7. Master's Degree: Candidates applying for a Master's degree programme must possess at least five (5) O' level credit passes including Mathematics, English Language and any other three (3) subjects (as stipulated by the department) from at most two (2) sittings.

- **8. PhDs.**: Those applying for Ph.D. programmes must possess, among other things, at least five (5) credit passes including Mathematics, English Language and any other three (3) subjects (as specified by the department) from at most two (2) sittings.
- **9. Transcript Submissions**: Applicants seeking admission into any Postgraduate programmes (e.g. PGD, Masters in Law, Master's degree and PhDs etc) must ensure that their official transcripts are submitted to SCEPS before the admission process begins.

Those whose transcripts are not received on time may be granted provisional admission, with a grace period of six months for the submission of their transcripts to SCEPS. Failure to submit official transcripts within this grace period will result in forfeiture of their Provisional admissions.

- **10. Certificate Submission**: All Candidates must submit photocopies of all their previous academic certificates.
- **11. UTME Scores NOT needed**: Those seeking admission into SCEPS need NOT submit UTME scores.

# GENERAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

#### Postgraduate Diploma Programmes

To qualify for admission into Postgraduate Diploma (PGD) Programme, candidates must be graduates of the University of Uyo, or any other University recognized by the Senate of the University of Uyo, or a person who holds a qualification adjudged by the Senate of the University of Uyo to be equivalent to a First Degree not lower than a third class pass. Holders of a recognized Higher National Diploma with Lower Credit in the relevant disciplines could also apply.

Graduates who possess a minimum of Third Class in Sociology Anthropology or Social Work or other relevant courses from recognized tertiary institutions can also apply for Postgraduate Diploma in Public Order and Information Management. Credit passes in English and Mathematics plus any other 3 subjects in related course in WAEC and NECO are acceptable.

#### **Master's Degree Programme**

To qualify for admission into a Master's Degree Programme, applicants should be Bachelor's Degree holders of not lower than a Second Class Lower Division in any relevant discipline or a Postgraduate Diploma in their relevant field of study. Credit passes in English and Mathematics plus any other three (3) subjects in related courses in WAEC and NECO are acceptable.
